Wadebridge Foodbank provides three days worth of nutritionally balanced, dried and tinned food to local people in times of crisis. Food is given out in exchange for a voucher, distributed by local statutory and voluntary organisations such as schools, doctors, churches etc. It is available to anyone living in Wadebridge, Bodmin, Padstow and the surrounding rural areas.

Food is donated by local people, and the Foodbank is run by volunteers, but there are ongoing costs of running the Foodbank:

- rent for the shop,
- utility bills,
- transport/delivery,
- publicity.

We want to ensure that the Foodbank can be kept running so that we can continue to meet the needs of local people in crisis.


We need £500 a month to cover our running costs, and ensure our future sustainability. Would you consider committing to giving from just **£1 per month**, or maybe more?

What have we done so far?

In our first year we have :

- had 2,784 kg food donated,
- worked with 30 distributors,
- given out 129 boxes of food,
- fed 352 people 193 adults and 159 children,
- fed almost one person each day of the year.

Some reasons for referrals include benefit delay, low income, benefit cuts, domestic violence, and redundancy.

Foodboxes are only given out on receipt of a voucher. You can get one from local care professionals and other voluntary organisations (i.e. GP, social worker, school, health visitor, CAB, local churches etc). If you are unsure who to go to please contact us.
